- Pentecost was a day that was an ignition moment and it is the blueprint of how God ignites His people
- “When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be a tongue of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the spirit enabled them. Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard their own language being spoken.” Acts 2:1-6 NIV
- That morning the Jews would have read a passage about Moses going up Mt. Sinai to receive the law and they would have also read a passage about Ezekiel – these all happen in the midst of a divine windstorm and God’s presence is there with fire. So when they are walking down the street - they had that scripture fresh in their minds.
- God uses His word alongside the Holy Spirit to turn our heads and ignite our hearts that He is showing us a path. God was using his word to their head and to peak their curiosity and confirm that He was doing something that he wanted them to see. God’s Word was vital in that moment for the Jews passing by.
- “Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.” Psalm 119:105 - The Word was lighting the path for those men then. We need God’s Word to light our path as He did then and how He does now.
- “Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him” Romans 6:8 NIV
- “You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.” Matthew 5:14-16 NIV
- Rooted Moms is working to build lampstands— to ignite moms, to ignite the entire family to be a beacon on a hill. When the house is full of light, your house is no longer just a house. Your house is now a beacon, it’s a lighthouse shining out for everyone to see.

When people walk by, that light will not stay contained.

- “The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.” John 1:6 NIV
- When people are in darkness, they notice the light. When a house is full of light, it will shine out into the darkness. Use God’s Word to be a light and to ignite those around you to do the same.
